I wanted to write a quick note about Office J. O'Connor #3320 and his honorable service. I was involved in a hit and run accident. A large truck sideswiped the left rear of my vehicle when I was driving on Route 202. I called 911 when the vehicle did not stop, and I was lucky to have obtained the tag number and vehicle description.
